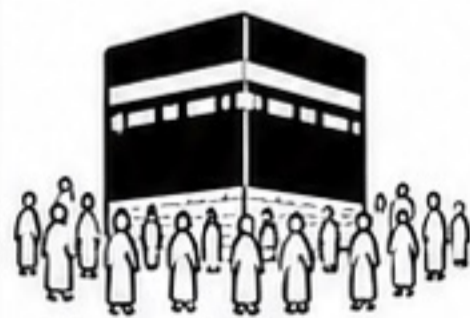
Ihram

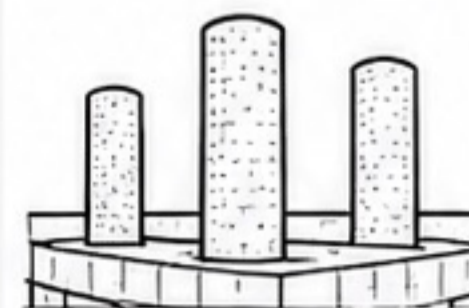
Arafah

May Allah accept (good deeds) from us and from you.

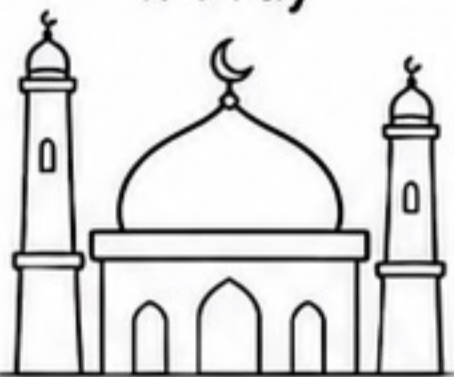
It is a time to worship Allah, help those in need and share our blessings.

May your Eid be filled with barakah, happiness and countless blessings.

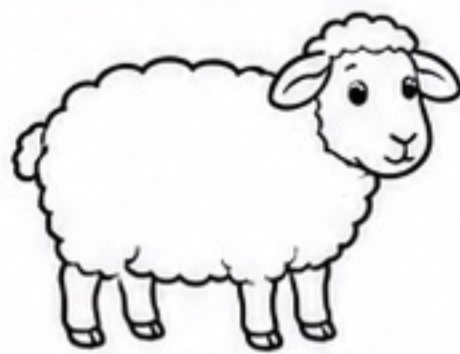
What We Do on Eid-ul-Adha

1. Pray



We pray Eid Salah and thank Allah for His blessings.

2. Sacrifice



We offer Qurbani as an act of worship and follow the Sunnah of Ibrahim (AS).

3. Share



We share the meat with our family, friends and those in need.

4. Give Thanks



We make dua and say Alhamdulillah for all that Allah has given us.

5. Spread Joy



We visit loved ones, exchange wishes and spread happiness.

- 😊 It brings rewards and blessings.

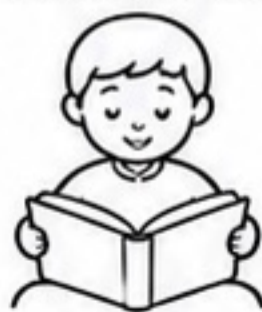
How Can We Read the Qur'an?

Understand the meaning.



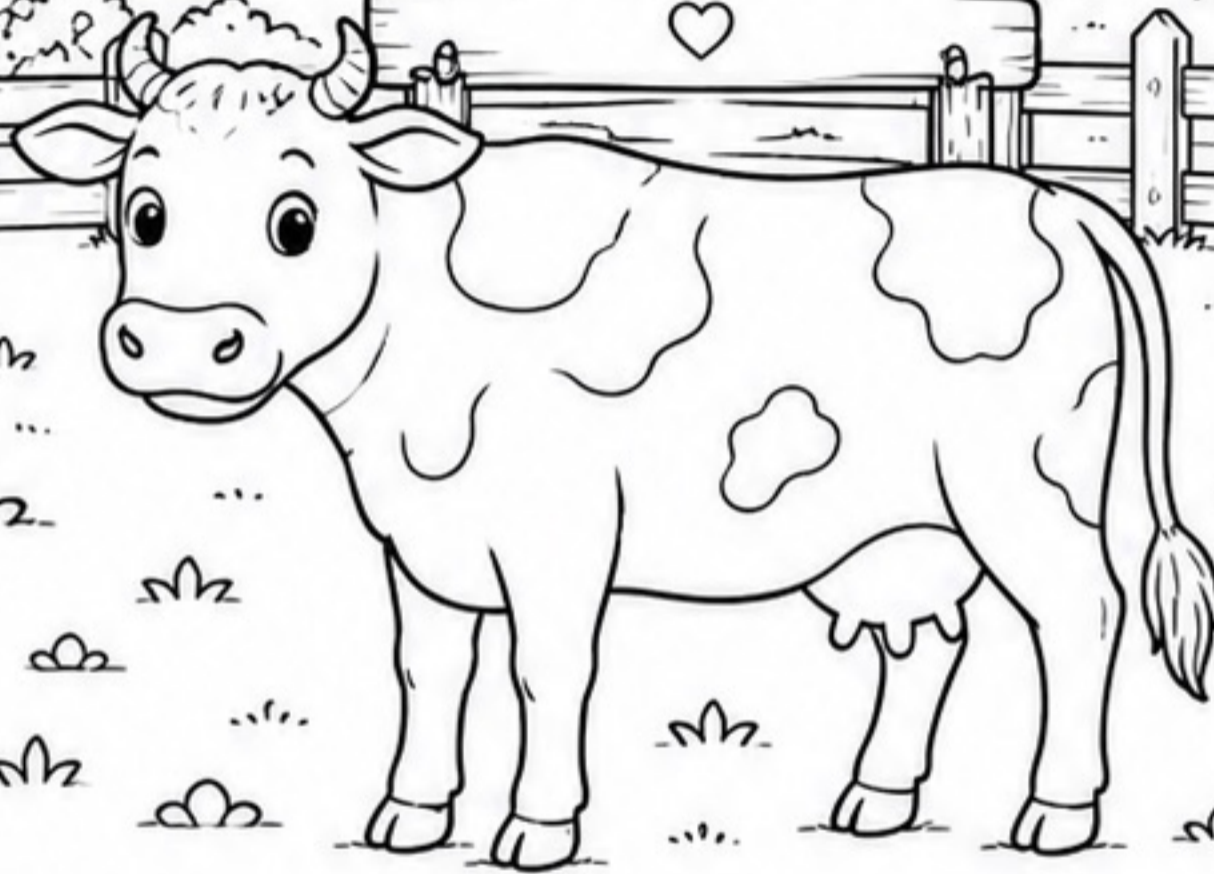
Apply it in our daily lives.

SHEEP



- ♥ Sheep are gentle and have soft, warm wool.
- ♥ They are strong and healthy animals.
- ♥ They are one of the animals we can sacrifice for Qurbani.

COW



- ♥ Cows give us milk and are very beneficial.
- ♥ They are large and strong animals.
- ♥ Cows are also a valid animal for Qurbani.

GOAT



- ♥ Goats are active and hardy animals.
- ♥ They can live in different places and climates.
- ♥ Goats are one of the animals for Qurbani.
